

## Information & Guidelines

Dear Participant,

Thank you for attending the Devil's Lake Anniversary Hike. Here are some instructions designed to insure your having a great experience.

ALL participants attending this event must wear their wristbands (issued with your packets at registration) for the entire weekend.

All campsites are assigned.

***First Aid:*** The main first aid stations are in campsites 201 & 202. First aid teams will be on the bluffs at checkpoints on Saturday (see map for locations). All will be covered with a radio network. Contact them for needed assistance.

### ***UNITS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VANDALISM AND WILL BEAR THE COST.***

Fires should be built in spaces provided and put out at bedtime or when left unattended. A fire watch will put out fires considered to be dangerous.

Adults must be in attendance at all functions – hiking the trail, the dance, the record spin. Units must hike together on the trail. **Hikers without adult leadership will be stopped at the checkpoints and held until all are present.**

***Conduct:*** It is essential that all hikers maintain a high standard of courtesy along the trail. The trail is rugged and hazardous. Horseplay and conduct leading toward accidents cannot be tolerated. **The rocks can be dangerous or even deadly. It is imperative that hikers stay OFF the rocks.**

### **SPECIFICS FOR SATURDAY**

DRY HIKING CONDITIONS - Trails opens at 8:00 am. All hikers must be on the trail no later than 3:00 pm.

Unit trail number cards must be carried on the trail and be presented at ALL checkpoints.

Groups with **odd campsite numbers** will begin at **checkpoint #1**

(Base of the west bluff, across from the Nature Center).

Groups with **even campsite numbers** will begin at **checkpoint #4**

(Base of the east bluff, across the railroad tracks from the bathhouse).

WET HIKING CONDITIONS - Trails opens at 8:00 am. All hikers must be on the trail no later than 1:00 pm.

Unit trail number cards must be carried on the trail and be presented at ALL checkpoints.

**ALL GROUPS WILL BEGIN AT CHECKPOINT #1** (Base of the east bluff, across the railroad tracks from the bathhouse – *a.k.a. dry trail checkpoint #4*).

AWARDS - Trail awards, past anniversary patches, and medals will be on sale at checkpoint eight from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm and at the dance from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Awards **will not** be available for purchase on Sunday.

THE DANCE \* - 7:00 pm to 10:00 pm (open only to youth 14 years of age and older)

Located in the CONCESSION BUILDING

**ALL ATTENDEES MUST WEAR THEIR WRISTBANDS.**

RECORD SPIN \* - 6:50 pm to 9:50 pm (open only to youth 13 years of age and younger)

Located at the BATHHOUSE
